FROM THE PASTOR

Resurrection Day is a day of joy and victory, but on that first resurrection day there was gloom and sadness. Mark tells us the disciples ‘mourned and wept’ when they should have been rejoicing. The death of Christ alone is no comfort to us. It leaves us in gloom and despair. It is the resurrection which gives meaning to the Cross. It is the capstone of the Gospel. The death of Christ alone is *bad news*, but followed by the resurrection is *good news*. Why? The resurrection is the proof that *sin is put away*. Had one single sin remained unatoned for, Christ could not have risen. His resurrection is the assurance that the work is finished. God was satisfied and demonstrated it by raising Him from the dead (Acts 13:32,33). Hallelujah! Yes, the Lord is risen indeed!
Remember, live as if Christ died yesterday, arose this morning, and is coming back tomorrow.
